I must admit, some rescue people are a pain in the ass but the BAFN and it's volunteers are great. I fostered a 4 yr old, 120 lb Rottweiler and I adopted a 3 yr old Staffordshire Terrier.

I was not subject to an intrusive anal probe, my anus was actually never mentioned or touched. I did have to fill out a quick application and I had someone visit my home to make sure that I had the adequate facilities for the animals.

Both of these dogs I took in had Kennel Cough and the BAFN paid for the vet visits and medications. They even picked them up at my home and dropped them off when they were done with the vet.

I was also supplied with leashes, collars, crates, food and countless tips to make my fostering experience go as smoothly as possible.

I had tried to adopt a dog from a rescue organization for about 6 month's before I came across BAFN. One group that I will not mention was supposed to drop of dogs that badly needed homes and stood me up 4 times!

Bottom line is, BAFN is great and they do not profit from adoptions... Let's try to help them out instead of spreading lies and rumors.
